## *Packing List*

We are planning a great camp for you! Please read the following information so you can have the best camp experience possible.

**What to Bring:** Sleeping bag or bed roll, pillow, flashlight, BIBLE, pen, note paper warm winter clothing, warm coat, (IT WILL BE COLD) towel, soap, toothbrush & toothpaste, and other personal items needed for your stay at camp.
